The gauges listed above reflect measurement of inside rail to inside rail and arise from railways which have operated or are operating 1 mile or more (1.6 kilometres or more) in Australia since 1831 when Australian Agricultural Company built Australia's first railway in Newcastle, NSW to export coal.

Only Anglo Cape Narrow operates in all States, Stephenson Standard operates in all mainland States, and to Darwin with FreightLink and The Ghan in 2004.
